This session will be an overview of ADHD and how issues with impulsivity and/or inattention impact children's ability to manage their environments.

The session will also explore the impact ADHD has on Executive Functioning and how it relates to managing everyday tasks, and meeting daily expectations at home and at school, including social, emotional, behavioural and academic demands.
