

ReDirect Key Behaviours

NORMAL BEHAVIOUR

These behaviours can be considered normal, healthy behaviours of personal development.

CONCERNING BEHAVIOUR

These behaviours can be associated with a person that indicates personal crisis.

WORRISOME BEHAVIOUR

These behaviours can be associated with a person on a trajectory of radicalization.

CRITICAL BEHAVIOUR

These behaviours can be associated to a person aligned to an ideology that supports the use of violence as the only way to achieve political or social change.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Strongly defends personal views in debate. Expresses cultural and/or religious identity through clothing, symbols, tattoos, jewelry or other non-discriminatory items. Active on social media in a non-offensive manner. Participates peacefully in democratic activism. Adopts new ideological beliefs that do not conflict with democratic values. Constructively challenges or supports policies of Canadian or foreign governments. Deepens existing faith or adopts a new religious faith. Display's typical youth behaviours such as mood swings, rebellion, or adult-to-youth boundary testing. <p>Engagement with ReDirect is not necessary.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begins to isolate themselves from family or close friends. Expresses a sense of rejection and/or victimization by the community. Expresses a conspiracy theory that goes beyond general societal concern. Expresses views that are mistrusting in nature. Friends, family or others are concerned about mental well being. Sudden and noticeable change in habits. Struggles to achieve goals they have set themselves. Shows intolerance to people who disagree with their view. Struggles with their own identity. <p>Seek help from community organizations, friends, family, or a faith leader; or contact ReDirect for advice.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sudden disengagement from school, work, family or friends. Spends time exclusively with a new individual or group. Expresses a religious obligation to stop evil and accepts the possibility of martyrdom. Posts and shares material that supports an extremist group ideology, or activity. Is secretive about their activities. Possesses propaganda materials of an extremist group. Noticeable out of character behaviours since travelling abroad. Rapidly sells all personal property. Fixated with a social or political issue that increasingly defines their behaviour. Changes their clothing or appearance to support a violent ideology. Expresses views that dehumanize others. <p>Someone observing these behaviours should not hesitate to contact ReDirect.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attitude that legitimizes violence or other criminal behaviour to further a political or social cause. Associates with other people that are known to hold undemocratic, extremist, or violent ideologies. Is actively in contact with an extremist/ terrorist group or network. Actively tries to recruit others to an ideological cause that encourages the use of violence to bring about social or political change. Actively supports an extremist/ terrorist group that can include: distributing propaganda material or financial support. Commits or plans acts of violence in pursuit of an ideological cause. Is actively planning to travel to a conflict zone to engage in or support violence. <p>A person observing these behaviours should contact ReDirect immediately. If the person may be at imminent risk of harming themselves or others, call 9-1-1.</p>
