# ReDirect Key Behaviours

#### **NORMAL BEHAVIOUR**

These behaviours can be considered normal, healthy behaviours of personal development.

### **CONCERNING BEHAVIOUR**

These behaviours can be associated with a person that indicates personal crisis.

#### **WORRISOME BEHAVIOUR**

These behaviours can be associated with a person on a trajectory of radicalization.

#### **CRITICAL** BEHAVIOUR

These behaviours can be associated to a person aligned to an ideology that supports the use of violence as the only way to achieve political or social change.
