### Reflection Questions

- Were you aware this is what teachers go through?
- How has this impacted your understanding of confidentiality in schools?
- How can you support YOUR child to understand adults may be working to improve situations, even if your child doesn't see it happening?
- If YOUR child was *THAT* Child, what support would you want in the classroom/ school setting?

### Example of Step to Take

Should you wish to extend your learning, within a group, we suggest:

- **Create a group learning event.**  
Work collaboratively, seek approvals and notify appropriately as required.
- **Plan for this blended learning activity.**  
What do you need to communicate and to whom?  
What logistical considerations do you need to be aware of?  
Does your event require a facilitator? Who would be best to take on this role?
- **Review reflection question handout.**  
Add to reflection questions to meet the needs of your school.
- **Watch this video as an individual.**
- **Come together to discuss video and how learnings may impact you and your school community.**

### We Want to Facilitate Our PD Day

**If your learners will view a module, as a pre-learning activity to your group discussion, we recommend the facilitator:**

- Views the MORE module(s) ahead of time
- Decides in advance which parts are most useful to review as a whole group, and where you can pause the presentation to encourage discussion.
- Begins by asking the participants what they most want to know about the topic, and revisit this at the end.
- Reviews Key Resources with participants, for further application and strategies to use in the classroom.
